

## Mowing and Weeding Bids

City of Owenton is taking bids for mowing and weeding in the city for fiscal year 2024-2025. Sealed bids will be accepted until close of business July 31, 2024. See below for information on what the bid should include. Turn in sealed bids at City Hall by the end of day July 31, 2024. Bids will be open and awarded at City Council Meeting August 8, 2024

## Mowing and Weeding Bid Packet

### Fiscal Year 2024/2025

The purpose of this bid is to secure a contract to complete the mowing, weeding, and spraying needs of the City. Below is a statement of duties the city expects to be completed should the contract be awarded to you:

- Weekly mowing of 127 corridor of the City of Owenton starting at Ellis Highway entrance and ending at the Lower Elementary property line. One pass in either direction including weed eating of any pole, signpost, or utility structure encountered on this route.
- Weekly mowing of the three City of Owenton signs located on 127 south, 127 north, and 22 east.
- Weekly mowing and weed eating of Owenton City Hall and Owenton/Owen County Fire Department properties.
- Mowing of the field behind City Hall 4 times a year.
- Three (3) sprayings of the entire city street and sidewalk system throughout the year. If you are awarded the contract and do not complete the spraying of pesticides yourself, the person you subcontract to complete the sprayings should submit their licenses and spraying records to City Hall.
- In the event of heavy rains or severe droughts and it is impossible or undesirable to mow, the contract award winner shall contact the Mayor or City Clerk to discuss if action should be taken.
- Should an injury, property damage, or alteration take place while performing your duties take place, you, the contract award winner should contact Owenton City Police or an Owen County Sheriff's Deputy to make a police report of the incident.

All bids should include proof of Liability Insurance and Workman's Comp.
